This implies first  $\underline{\text{turning to God}}$  (v. 30). This is probably the first and most crucial step. The next step is just as important, namely to seek Him with all our heart and soul. In other words, we must sincerely seek Him as if our life

depended on it. The Bible clearly tells us that we will find Him because He is a *merciful* God (v.30), who longs for us to always be near Him where we are always safe.
